- Up to 800 journals have been yearly subscribed to
- Ca. 8.500 e-books have been made available Open Access


New

- We will enrich our virtual library MENALIB with new features (search options, information on MENA related issues)

In order to increase the visibility, generate citability and provide a permanent and free access to these titles, the SIS catalogues them according to librarian standards and hosts a copy of the documents on its repository MENAdoc.

Since 2016, the SIS provides researchers with the option to (re)publish relevant publications on the Middle East and Islamic Studies on MENAdoc as Open Access titles.
