1. Venue

The address for the Aga Khan Library is:

The Aga Khan Centre is located in the northern section of the Kings Cross area, behind the University of the Arts London - Central St. Martins (UAL-CSM) and very close to Coal Drops Yard.

How to get here via public transport

The Aga Khan Centre is a 10-minute walk from St Pancras International train station and King's Cross train and underground stations.

Leaving the stations and keeping King's Cross station always to your right, start your journey from **Battle Bridge Place**. We recommend you walk along **King's Boulevard**, a pedestrian route going north. At the end of King's Boulevard, on your left, you will see a clothes shop called &*Other Stories* and in front of you two pedestrian crossings over the canal towards **Granary Square**.

Cross the canal and walk towards the left corner of the large brick building that houses some restaurants and cafes. At the corner, turn right and follow **Stable St**., leaving **Coal Drops Yard** to your left. You will find the Aga Khan Centre at the end, besides **Lewis Cubitt Park**.

If you are coming by bus, the best option is Route 390. Alight at Stop E (Copenhagen St/York Way).

2. On the day of the conference

Conference registration will take place on **Tuesday 14th May** from **9am to 10.15am**.
